

## **STORMWATER ORDINANCE REVIEW WORKING GROUP**

Summary notes from the meeting of February 10, 2010

---

The following is a summary of the notes from the working group at the meeting on January 13, 2010. For clarity and consistency, the notes have been edited.

### General

Jurisdictional coordination is very important in terms of process, as well as regulations and requirements.

- Federal, state and county.
- City and county.

When dealing with stormwater, soil types and slope are part of the issue.

Better enforcement is always an issue, which may be related to having more trained staff.

There needs to be agreement among the various review agencies, as well as developers, regarding the “plan of record”, or “official” plan. What plan controls how a property can be developed? When does a developer know when he/she has received all the required approvals and permits?

Care should be taken when using GIS to develop stormwater plans. Is the information being used to form the basis for proposed stormwater plans current and accurate?
